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# Cooperation of the State Road Safety Service with The Sectoral Services of Internal Affairs Bodies in Road Safety Activities

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**Abstract.** Road safety has always been under the special attention of the government of Uzbekistan. Since 1991, when Uzbekistan became independent, more than 100 laws and by-laws related to road safety, traffic rules, training and education, vehicle inspection, insurance, etc. have been adopted. It should be recognized that there are common legal frameworks, road design standards, vehicle design specifications and road safety management frameworks. As in many countries, the question arises whether these documents are up to date and how these laws are implemented in practice.

**Keywords:** Speed Management, Traffic Organization, Speed Control Measures

The cooperation of the ranks of the State Traffic Service is responsible for maintaining public order, preventing crimes and violations in the streets and public places, ensuring traffic safety, identifying and apprehending criminals and wanted persons, the vehicles in which they are moving, and combating terrorist and subversive acts. provided by providing direct practical assistance to each other in the performance of assigned tasks (according to the purpose, time and place).

Successful performance of the tasks entrusted to internal affairs bodies from the leadership of regional internal affairs bodies and commanders of line divisions:

joint study, evaluation and continuous exchange of information on the operational situation;

jointly develop, plan and carry out measures to maintain public order and ensure road safety;

implementation of joint patrol service of the squads;

conducting training sessions and practical exercises aimed at strengthening cooperation with personnel;

in cooperation with the commanders of the line units, timely preparation of the ranks for the pre-service joint instructions, personally participating in it, continuous management of the ranks in accordance with the daily decision;

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purposeful distribution and direction of forces and means, proper organization of their actions in mutual cooperation and effective use of them based on the "single location" plan;

development of the location (dislocation) of forces and means of joint subordination in terms of posts and patrol directions, taking into account the immediate situation;

determining the procedure and methods of joint service;

to ensure the active participation of patrol post and road patrol service employees in maintaining public order in their posts and patrol routes, detecting and preventing crimes, and ensuring traffic safety;

to analyze and review the work and results of work carried out in cooperation by the commanders of the patrol-post and road-patrol line units, as well as the operational situation, and agree on the procedure for coordinating the movement of all ranks and personnel;

establishing control over the continuous operation of means of communication and determining the order of communication between patrol-post and road-patrol units;

service, including the detection and elimination of offenses, the capture and neutralization of criminals and the vehicles in which they are moving, the preparation and holding of public events, the maintenance of public order, and the provision of road safety require mutual exchange of work experience.

The Central Information Dispatch Service is responsible for recording the received urgent information, delivering it to the responsible managers and duty units of higher authorities (IIV-IIBB-IIB), managing the forces and means of the State Traffic Safety Service units, and cooperating with other services of the internal affairs bodies.

The Central Information Dispatch Service carries out its activities using modern technologies and information systems, the Road Patrol Service coordinates the forces of the frontline units, ensures the effective performance of the computerized control system for traffic safety management and public order protection, and monitors the traffic flow. and ensures their non-stop movement.

The Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Republic of Karakalpakstan, the duty units of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the city of Tashkent and the regional Ministry of Internal Affairs (IIMB), commanders of road patrol service units (brigade, battalion, squad), Central Information Dispatch Service - information dispatch service, as well as branches, mobile groups and Road Patrol service crews, helicopter patrol group, city-district IIB duty units, patrol-post service units and bases directly and, if necessary, in accordance with special action plans of the State Security Service, Ministry of Emergency Situations, State Customs Committee, Border Guards and neighboring states establish and maintain rapid communication with law enforcement agencies in accordance with the scheme defined in the regulatory legal document.

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The units of the road patrol service ensure traffic safety and public order in their area of responsibility and the fight against crimes on highways and areas connected to them.

Post-patrol and road patrol services consist of crews of mobile groups, which together with patrol-post service, prevention inspectors, criminal investigation officers, break traffic rules, traffic-related crimes, drivers hiding from the scene of the accident and other crimes committed in the service areas. take measures to expose.

The Central Information Dispatch Service - information dispatch service, as well as its branches, mobile group, immediate commanders, neighboring crews, helicopter patrolling team, in the organization of traffic safety and public order maintenance in the area and area of responsibility of the road patrol service crew The duty units, base stations, and post-patrol service crews of the city-district IIBs cooperate by exchanging information, maintain constant rapid communication, and in accordance with the joint plan for conducting rapid search activities, according to the scheme defined in the normative legal act on the assignment. performs actions.

The places of service of helicopter patrolling groups are determined by the leadership of the Ministry of Internal Affairs and Communications. Central Information Dispatch Service - Information Dispatch Service, as well as its branches, and city-district IIBs are on duty in order to catch and identify vehicles that have been hijacked, stolen, and hidden from the scene, and to eliminate subversive-terrorist and religious extremist groups, as well as groups aimed at overthrowing the constitutional system. cooperates with units, base stations, post-patrol service crews, constantly informs them about the situation and maintains rapid communication in accordance with the scheme established by the regulatory legal document.

The commanders of the post-patrol and road-patrol service units carry out the following in order to train personnel for service and conduct joint training:

- one day in advance, he submits the list of orders to the post and route to the management for inclusion in the daily decision;
- ensures that employees assigned to the service arrive at the internal affairs department or a specially designated place at least 15 minutes before the start of the instruction. Controls the receipt of necessary weapons and armor, means of communication, special protective and special equipment, service documents, and records and signs them in the book of distribution to posts and patrol lines;
- arranges the order for instructions, announces the post and service time, introduces information about committed crimes, wanted persons, seized and stolen vehicles, monitors their registration in service booklets;
- -checks that every employee entering the service is fully equipped with clothing, appearance and special service equipment and takes measures to eliminate identified deficiencies;
  - informs the supervisor about the readiness of the staff to perform the service;

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- when the employee's absenteeism is determined, the reason for his/her absence is determined, and the supervisor giving the instructions informs the employee about the position or direction that remains open;
- based on the instruction of the supervisor, he makes changes to the book of distribution of posts and patrol routes and informs the duty unit (Central Information Dispatch Service - Information Dispatch Service, as well as its branches);
- checking the technical condition of the motor vehicles that are brought into the service of the post-patrol and road patrol service units after the order;
- in accordance with the adopted decision, he supervises the organization and transfer of the service of orders, the implementation of the work of putting orders into service using personal composition and patrol motor vehicles, as provided for in the book of marking posts and routes.

In the process of preparing for public events and conducting them, post-patrol and road patrol service units are involved based on the plans developed for this event and the distribution of forces. Therefore, the commanders of the post-patrol and road-patrol services are assigned the task of organizing and controlling the service of the personnel involved in the event according to the specified directions, and eliminating the identified deficiencies in time.

Reconnaissance is carried out with post-patrol and road-patrol services and other sectoral services in preparation for important international and republican public events.

The Central Information Dispatch Service takes a leading position in the management of forces and means in extreme situations, and ensures the implementation of rapid search activities that cannot be delayed based on the requirements of normative legal documents. The Central Information Dispatch Service performs non-stop rapid monitoring of the progress of the specified event, provides all-round assistance in managing the forces and means to the mobile groups of the Road Patrol Service, patrol post service units, if necessary.

At the moment, when an operational situation is declared, the forces and means of the Road Patrol service units will be subordinated to the operational headquarters of the Ministry of Internal Affairs, the Ministry of Internal Affairs, the Ministry of Internal Affairs and Communications.

In the conditions of extreme situations, the execution of additional tasks for traffic control is assigned to the checkpoints.

During public events and emergency situations, security is provided based on special plans of the Ministry of Internal Affairs and Communications. During the planned events, the deployment of the forces and means of the Road Patrol Service is carried out by the heads of the units.

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In the case of natural disasters, epizootics and other emergency situations, operational and emergency medical services, internal affairs bodies help the unhindered movement of forces and equipment in the region where extreme conditions have arisen, restore and maintain public order, rescue people and property, provide necessary assistance to victims, takes measures to protect the remaining property.

Takes measures to maintain public order, prevent and eliminate criminal and administrative violations, monitors the behavior of citizens around the territory of the service.

When traffic difficulties arise as a result of a natural disaster, the YPX employee informs the duty officer about it and takes measures to inform drivers about the danger. If necessary, temporarily restricts or prohibits movement, directs vehicles to bypass the dangerous area, organizes assistance to victims.

Investigate the situation in other places where mass events are held and where people are crowded, the post-patrol service duty units, the Central Information Dispatch Service - the information dispatch service or its branches, and the head of the line and the IIB duty officer will immediately report on the situations that lead to a group violation of public order.

The order of subordination, behavior and mutual cooperation of Post-patrol and Road-patrol service teams in eliminating group violation of public order is determined by the regulatory legal documents of the Ministry of Internal Affairs and current special plans.

With the arrival of special specialists to carry out security and decontamination work, the duties and actions of the team will be further determined.

In emergency cases of road patrol service contingents related to natural disasters, the Central Information Dispatch Service - Information Dispatch Service or its affiliates, the head of the squad and the IIB duty officer are immediately informed of all available information regarding the emergency situation.

Road patrol service teams pay particular attention to participation in the implementation of measures aimed at the normal operation of very important, classified and life-supporting objects.

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
