

Topic: The system of training of personnel with secondary special, vocational education for the agricultural sector in Karakalpak stan.

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Annotation. This article focuses on the information about the training of agricultural workers who were captured during the independence period in Karakalpakstan. Among them, the issues of training of personnel with secondary vocational education in the field of agricultural economy, opening of secondary vocational colleges and the training of agrarian specialists there are three opportunities that have been opened. provided information about it.

Key words: rural economy, secondary education, farmers' school, agricultural technology, irrigation and water management.

Significant progress has been made due to the gradual implementation of reforms in the development of agriculture in our country. During the years of independence, important strategic guidelines aimed at ensuring the stability of the country's economy were developed and their consistent implementation is bearing fruit.

The Law "On the foundations of national policy related to youth in the Republic of Uzbekistan" adopted on November 20, 1991 is one of the first laws of our Republic. One line Patman and the decisions of the President of our country are aimed at creating the conditions of existence for the young generation to become fully mature.

In accordance with the Law "On Education" and the national direction of personnel training, a system of continuous education aimed at training necessary specialists for the rapidly developing economic sectors and the public sphere was achieved in our country.

Modern schools, lyceums and vocational colleges have been built in the villages as well. The results of these works did not leave international cooperation indifferent. In 2012, at an inter-population conference on "Education of a highly educated and intellectually developed generation - the most important condition for sustainable development and modernization of the country" held in Tashkent, the national model of continuous education and training implemented in Uzbekistan was discussed by experts in other countries. provided as an example for.

The development of market conditions requires the productive and qualitative growth of agricultural products.

All conditions are being created for the implementation of innovative features in the agricultural enterprises and bodies of our country, and for showing the creative abilities of personnel. Cooperation between agricultural colleges and the District Council of Farmers has been established in the districts. "Farmers' School" was established in them, and the measures for the joint implementation of theory and practice are included. Bird breeding, beekeeping, intensive fish breeding methods are being studied in the experimental farms of the colleges.

Emphasis is placed on teaching the students of vocational colleges who are studying in the field of agriculture on the basis of new pedagogical technologies, and in this way, to increase their knowledge. The decision¹ of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated August 11, 2014 "On the training system of personnel with secondary special, vocational education for the agricultural sector and measures to improve it" is serves to increase the scope of work.

R. Urazbaeva, doctor of historical sciences, explains² that in 2006, 25 colleges in Karakalpakstan will train agricultural specialists.

According to the decision of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated August 11, 2014 "On the system of training of personnel with secondary special, vocational education for the agricultural sector and measures to

improve it" measures to strengthen the material and technical base of vocational colleges, conditions for training specialists for the agricultural sector, and measures to improve quality. The Republican Secondary Special Vocational Education Center is also making sacrifices in this.

- In the future, the specified tasks are the quality of training of personnel in the field of agriculture, and in this context, continuous improvement, theoretical and practical training will help to develop the professional skills of students, - says the head of the Oreydin department. headmaster Rahmatilla Rustamov.- Currently, vocational colleges in the field of agriculture are to be provided with modern study-production equipment and agricultural techniques, study specialized subjects based on business plans, study pending review of the content of the links³.

In the colleges where specialists are trained in the agrarian field, comprehensive work is being carried out on the training of mechanics and drivers for the use, repair and maintenance of agricultural machinery and, in this regard, improvement. For example, the material and technical warehouse of 29 basic vocational colleges in the Republic of Karakalpakstan and the regions has been strengthened. In 2015-2017, 110 agricultural machines will be given to them.

According to the experts, allocation of plots of land for auxiliary farms to basic vocational colleges increases the level of effective organization of education and training.

Such high attention paid to the training of personnel will serve to further improve the process of training personnel with secondary special education in the agricultural sector in the future.

Statement of the meeting of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan on December 25, 2011 in Zardakizilgen "On the possibilities of improving the communication system between educational institutions and water management organizations in the field of training and professional development of personnel for water management" on the basis of the decision, 30 vocational colleges specializing in water management were attached to the Tashkent Institute of Irrigation and Reclamation in the Republic of Karakalpakstan and regions. There are: Nukus Water Management and Reclamation, Amudarya District Reclamation and Water Management, Chimboy Agricultural (Kyzilózek), Beruniy Agricultural and Khojeli Agricultural Vocational Colleges from the Republic of Karakalpakstan.

On 18.01.2014, on the basis of the order of the institute No. 18 A/F, he was on a service visit, and the tasks were carried out based on the questionnaire prepared in direct field directions. Among them: S.
